Who we are?

North Strathclyde Community Justice Authority is one of eight statutory bodies across Scotland with the aim of reducing reoffending.

Community Justice Authorities (CJAs) bring together Local Authorities and other key partners to provide a co-ordinated approach to offender services.

NSCJA is comprised of one elected member from each of the following Local Authority areas:

- Argyll and Bute
- East Dunbartonshire
- East Renfrewshire
- Inverclyde
- Renfrewshire
- West Dunbartonshire

What we will do?

Our statutory functions are to:

- Prepare a plan for reducing reoffending;
- Monitor the performance of bodies responsible for offender services;
- Report annually to Scottish Ministers on the progress of the plan;
- Promote good practice;
- Allocate resources provided by Scottish Ministers to local criminal justice social work service; and
- Arrange with partner bodies to share information about relevant persons
